Title page setup - APA Style

The sixth edition provides explicit rules for direct quotations and states that you must credit the source when “ paraphrasing, quoting an author directly, or describing an idea that influenced your work ” (p. 170). If the quotation is less than 40 words, incorporate the quotation into the text and place quotation marks round the quotation.

APA recommends that your title be focused and succinct and that it should not contain abbreviations or words that serve no purpose. Your title may take up one or two lines. All text on the title page, and throughout your paper, should be double-spaced. Beneath the title, type the author's name: first name, middle initial (s), and last name.

Your main body should follow all of the rules outlined in the Basic Formatting tab. The full title of your paper should be at the top of the first page of the main body. It should not be bolded or italicized, and it should be in title case. There should be no extra spaces between the title and the beginning of your paper.
