A DBQ (document-based question) is designed to build students' critical thinking skills by asking them to interpret, analyze and synthesize information from primary sources. The goal in using document-based questions is to get students to look beyond the obvious interpretation of a primary source to understand not just what the document, object, or artifact shows and says, but more importantly what it means.
